Alaska Congressional Delegation Updates

Akacia Halliday-Isaac, Senator Sullivan's Office (Sea Grant Knauss Fellow)

- New Fellow: applied through Mississippi-Alabama Sea Grant Consortium
- Working on adding seafood provisions to the Farm Bill. Carina is coordinating a House and Senate letter to add these provisions.
- Introduced a National Pacific Research Board Enhancement Act. This will help with funding for North Pacific Research Board (NPRB) and also add a Tribal seat to the Board.
- Working on <u>Harmful Algal Bloom and Hypoxia Research and Control Amendments Act</u> (HABHRCA) reauthorization.
